GENERAL ELECTION VOTER GUIDE

Every vote counts—make sure
to turn in your ballot on-time!

There are two ways you can vote!

- 1 All active registered voters in Sacramento, Placer, El Dorado, Sutter, Yolo and Yuba Counties will receive their official ballot in the mail after October 10. You can return your voted ballot at any Ballot Drop Box, Vote Center/Voter Assistance Centers, or mail it back—no stamp needed!

- 2 All six counties will have vote or polling sites open for in-person voting and ballot drop offs from October 29 through November 8. Due to COVID19, health and safety protocols may be in place including social distancing and request for masks. Be prepared for lines.
